

ABBOTT CLAIM VINEYARD

SOIL TYPE - Marine Sedimentary

ELEVATION - 330 - 480ft.

 ${\tt LOCATION}$ - $11011~{\tt NE}$ Bayliss Rd. Carlton, OR 97111

SANDSTONE - 50-million-year-old eroded, oceanic sandstone, bare, without topsoil. Orientate is sourced from these low-yielding blocks.

TRUFFLE FOREST - Dense, rich forest, surrounding and adding to the cool microclimate of block E1, where we source Due North.

MONARCH HABITAT - A collaboration with the Pollinator Partnership and Monarch Wings Over the West, providing seasonal Monarch Butterfly habitat.

REFORESTATION - Quercus garryana specimens planted alongside native plants to repopulate areas with forest and recreate a native oak savannah.

WORM FARM - The first of its kind for an Oregon winery, this system relies on earthworms to clean and reclaim wastewater, while producing nutrient-rich compost.

GRAIN - A collaboration with a local farmer, the lower fertile portions are a mix of wooded wetland and a rotational selection of certified organic grains.

SOLAR PANELS - Solar panels on the winery roof, offsetting 100% of our annual electricity usage.
